

# GCSE Photography

Over the 2 years of the GCSE course students will create 2 coursework projects (60% of the marks). This is followed by an exam project with themes set by the exam board (40% of the marks), taking 12 weeks finishing with a 10 hour practical exam. These projects fulfil the assessment objectives for the GCSE course from AQA.

**Record** – Research and observe through photography and other visual sources.

**Develop** – Investigate the theme through artists and photographers techniques and analysis.

**Refine** – Experimentation and use of a wide range of media and techniques

**Present** – Bring together the whole project to a final conclusion.
