## **Year 11 Geography Curriculum Overview**

In year 11 we study the second half of the GCSE course and revise for the final exams.

1. Controlled Assessment (15 hours)
2. Rivers
  - How do rivers shape the landscape?
3. Economic Development
  - Why are there differences in economic development around the world?
  - How can economic development affect the environment and people?
4. Revision

## **Year 11 fieldwork**

There will be a coastal fieldtrip to Lulworth Cove in the autumn term which is for the controlled assessment.

## **Assessment**

Assessment of the GCSE Geography course is based on three elements. Their weightings are in brackets.

1. Geographical Themes Exam Paper. Students sit this in the summer of year 11. Students are assessed on three of the above themes. (50%)
2. Sustainable Decision Making Exam Paper. This exam is in the summer of year 11 and it is based on one of the above themes. (25%)
4. Fieldwork Focus Controlled Assessment. A 2000 word report produced in controlled conditions in the Autumn term of year 11 based on fieldwork. (25%)
