During Key Stage 3 we study a wide range of techniques and media. This will develop their skills to the level required for the GCSE should they wish to continue the subject further.

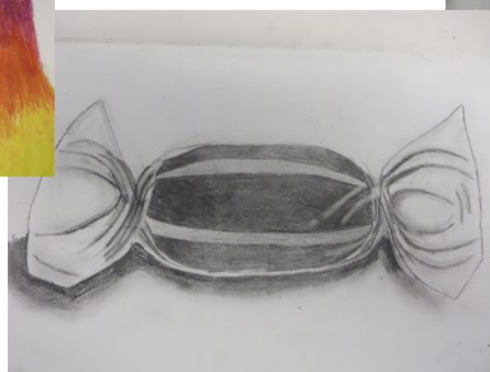
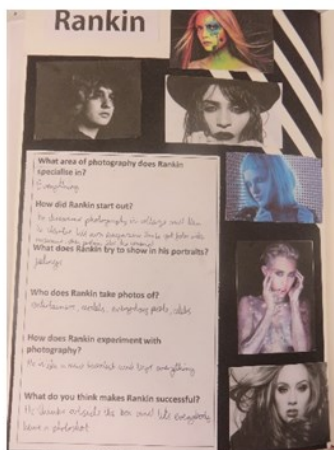
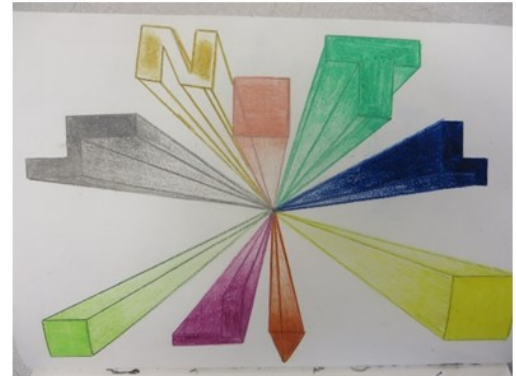
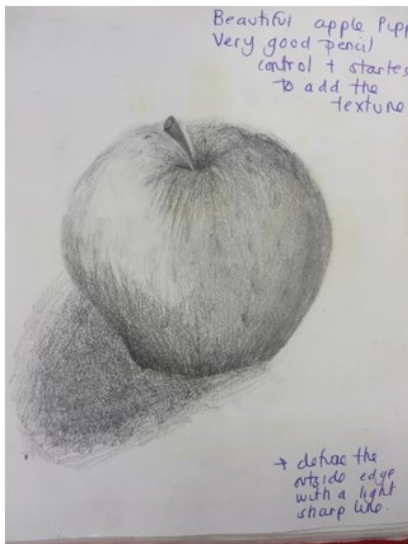
There are four projects taught each year and focus on a particular set of skills:

In Year 7 the key skills covered are pencil drawing, 3D construction, colour theory, painting, photography, and collage.

In Year 8 the key skills covered are portrait drawings, photography, biro drawing, mixed media, 3D construction and perspective.

Assessment

At the end of each project students work is assessed on the key skills taught in that project. In addition homework that is set fortnightly to support the classwork.
